Class 128 The Joseph Brown Vats Gardener of the Year

(Open to all)

To be staged within an area 2ft 6" deep x 1ft 6" wide

One 8" bikini vase cut flowers (max 20 points)

One pot plant - excluding vegetable/herb (max 20 points)

One dish vegetables, one kind (max 20 points)

To be judged on points, with a maximum of 5 points being awarded for presentation.

1st Prize (5 points) £10.00

2nd Prize (4 points) £5.00

3rd Prize (3 points) £4.00

4th Prize (1 points) £3.00

VEGETABLES - Hints and Tips

Clean root vegetables by washing with a soft sponge in plenty of water - taking care not to damage the skin. Where appropriate, leave approx. 3" of leaf stalks attached.

Avoid over skinning onions and shallots: these should have well ripened skins, their necks tied with raffia and roots trimmed back to the basal plate.

Ideal sizes: courgettes - 4"-8", beetroot - tennis ball size: 2"-3", turnips - cricket ball size: 2 ½ "-3", potatoes - 6-8oz.
